

DIVINE HEALING EQUIPPING BELIEVERS TRAINING

Morrinsville, 30/31 March 2012

REPORT

The training conference commenced on Friday 30 March at 7pm with two 40 minute sessions. The first session was basically an introductory overview of the training and an introduction of the team, made up of Jared Hunt (Hamilton), and Naomi Rogers (Auckland). The second session dealt with the Word of God being our rule for principles and practice for divine healing.

The Saturday sessions started at 10am, and the 40 minute sessions dealt with New Covenant Christians, Healing in the Atonement, Healing and Faith (Jared Hunt), The ABCs of Divine Healing, Jesus and Divine Healing, and The Secret of Divine Healing. Naomi Rogers testified to her healing of the results of a botched operation on her leg which left her with what was thought to be a permanent disability.

The first practical session involved having a "hot seat" where a lady was prayed for by 30 people coming up one by one and ministering to her. The ones ministering were told not to ask Jesus to heal her because He has already provided it through the Atonement; nor were they to ask "if it be God's will" because we know it is always His will to heal. They were either to say, "You are healed", or "I cast out this spirit of infirmity", or to tell the affected part of her body to function normally and without pain. After the ministry session, she reported that all the pain she had been experiencing for a long time had disappeared and even her hard of hearing was improving! I received an email on the Monday of the next week to say that she was walking around with a permanent smile on her face, without pain, and she had the best night's sleep she has had for a very long time.

The last session for the day was made up of a general ministry time where everyone who had a medical condition was invited to come and sit on the front row. The whole of the front row was filled up. We then got all the others to line up on one side and for each person to go through the line and pray for each person. This meant that each person got ministered to by everyone else in the room.

Overall, it was a very successful Training conference, and the minister of the church in which the conference was held was very satisfied with the outcome. This is a town in which there are Healing Rooms, and the conference would have added to the expertise of those ministering to the sick in the Healing Rooms.

One of the aims I had for the conference was that it would result in a Divine Healing revival in the Eastern Waikato, as the 35 plus people went out with their new found boldness and started ministering to the sick in the community.

As a result of the success of the conference, I have been invited to conduct another Training Day at Te Awamutu, south of Hamilton. I was told that "our church is ready for this!"

Jared was invited to preach on the Sunday morning at the Morrinsville Assembly of God church, and he was a real blessing to them. I preached at Knox Presbyterian, and there was a good response to the offer of ministry for healing.

I think that there is a tremendous potential for having training days like this around the Auckland/Waikato region, because it is important that every believer learns that it is not only the prominent "anointed" or "gifted" ministries that can be effective for healing the sick. The Scripture says that "These signs shall fall those who believe...they shall lay hands on the sick and they shall recover." So, according to Scripture, the Divine Healing ministry is open to all believers.
